

Welcome to TBASSC's agility trial. Thank you for coming to our trial; we hope you have a great time. Thank you for your entry. The trial has now closed. This is all the information you need to know to get here and have fun with your dogs. Please check your confirmation carefully. PAPER MAPS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE TRIAL. THE RUNNING ORDERS WILL BE POSTED BEFORE THE TRIAL FOR ALL DAYS ON TUESDAY AFTER INITIAL MOVE-UPS ARE PROCESSED (which means daily move-ups are not included). Access this information at www.barc4agility.com and click on Events.

Please adhere to the following guidelines:

Crate setup will be allowed starting Thursday from 4-6 pm. Please pick up after your dogs. Dogs must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or using the warm-up jump - no exceptions!

Class entry numbers are posted earlier in this confirmation. CLASS ENTRY NUMBERS ARE CONTINGENT UPON MOVE-UPS NOT YET RECEIVED. The running order will be posted to the website the week of the trial after move-ups have closed.

JUDGING PROGRAM (Friday and Sunday are small to tall; Saturday is tall to small)
The site is open at 7:00 am. First dog on the line at 8 am.

WALK-THROUGHS will run as follows:

Friday (small to tall) – briefing at 7:40, walk thru starts at 7:47 am; first dog on line at 8 am:

FAST will have one walk thru for 8 minutes, then 5 minutes until first dog.
Master/Excellent JWW and STD will be split as such: walk/run 4-12, walk/run 16-24.
Open and Novice classes will each have one walk followed by 5 minutes until first dog.

Saturday (tall to small) – briefing at 7:45, walk thru starts at 7:47 am; first dog on line at 8 am:

FAST will have one walk thru for 8 minutes, then 5 minutes until first dog.
Master/Excellent JWW and STD will be split as such: walk 24-20, walk 16, run 24-16; walk 12, walk 8-4, run 12-4.
Premier, Open and Novice classes will each have one walk followed by 5 minutes until first dog.

Sunday (small to tall) – briefing at 7:45, walk thru starts at 7:47 am; first dog on line at 8 am:

T2B will have one walk thru for 8 minutes, then 5 minutes until first dog.

Master/Excellent JWW and STD will be split as such: walk 4-8, walk 12, run 4-12; walk 16, walk 20-24, run 16-24
Premier, Open and Novice classes will each have one walk followed by 5 minutes until first dog.

*****A NOTE ABOUT HOW WE ARE RUNNING FAST*****

Within each height we will run the Master, Excellent, Open and Novice dogs so there aren't as many height changes needed. I will spread dogs as much as possible, please do not move your dogs in the running order without asking me first since this can make a difference in your scoring and the judge has to know what bonus you're going for to qualify, and we have to make sure you run under the correct time. Thank you for your cooperation!

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move ups must be received by 6pm, the Monday before the trial. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to barc4agility@gmail.com with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any subsequent days even if you are not showing a dog that day. There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 30 minutes after the end of the last class. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial.

MEASURING

As of March 1, 2021, if a VMO or Agility Field Representative is measuring dogs at a trial, all present and entered dogs without a valid measurement must be measured. Until further notice, Judges of Record who are not VMOs will still not measure dogs. Jacqui O'Neill (yep, that's me), will be measuring at this event, however, if I did a previous official measurement for you then I can't do your second one as well.
