Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) •

(Please note – by publishing the information, this is your notification that the club is allowing FEO at this event.)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class.

FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show. Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge. Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

MOVE-UPS

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 30 minutes after the end of the last class. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial.

MEASURING

At this time, a measuring official will not be at this trial. If you have never had your dog measured, the judge of record will need to measure your dog BEFORE you run. This measurement will only be good for this trial weekend.
