

Welcome to DTCSP's agility trial. Thank you for coming to our trial; we hope you have a great time. This is all the information you need to know to get here and have fun with your dogs. Please check your confirmation carefully. If there are any errors contact Jacqui O'Neill, Trial Secretary, immediately at barc4agility@gmail.com. If you need to make corrections, please put "DTCSP entry" in your subject line.

Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Crate setup will be allowed the day before the trial between 4:00 to 6:00 pm or until course building is complete.
- NO crating is allowed in Building C (the building with the kitchen) until Friday morning due to Flyball practice Thursday night.
- Please clean up after your dogs.
- There are tv screens in all buildings for you to see what's happening in the ring. It is each competitor's responsibility to pay attention and be present for walk-thrus and at the ring to run their dogs at the appropriate time.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or using the warm-up jump.

Per AKC rules, the maps will be mailed out to competitors after midnight the morning of each trial day. THE RUNNING ORDERS WILL BE POSTED BEFORE THE TRIAL FOR ALL DAYS AFTER INITIAL MOVE-UPS ARE PROCESSED (which means daily move-ups are not included). JUDGING PROGRAM (Day 1 and 3 are tall to small; Day 2 is small to tall)
First dog on the line at 8 am. The site is open at 7:00 am.

WALK-THRUS

Will be split in Master/Excellent STD and JWW: 4-12 and 16-24. Each group will walk/run.

All other classes will have one walk unless the judge decides to split them at the trial.

MOVE-UPS

Pre-trial move-up deadline is Monday before the trial at 6 pm. There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 30 minutes after the end of the last class. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial.

MEASURING

Jacqui O'Neill (that's me) will be the measuring official at this trial. If you have never had your dog measured, you will need to measure your dog BEFORE you run.
